How do I add a CNAME to point my domain to web.mac.com?

Did you know that you can publish your iWeb created website to your Doteasy hosting account? You may be able to save your additional account service fees for Mobile Me. [View the tutorial.](#)

If you really want to publish to your Mobile Me account using your Doteasy domain, here are the steps.

Note: These instructions are for iWeb '08 only. Ensure that you have already setup a personal domain service with Mac.com or Me.com.

1. Open iWeb
2. Make sure you're connected to the Internet
3. From the File menu, choose Set Up Personal Domain
4. When the MobileMe login window appears, type in your account name and password and click Log In
5. Read the information in the Domain Settings window and click Add Domain
6. Enter your personal domain name in the Domain Name and Confirm Domain text fields and click Continue

After you get to this step, you need to open a web browser and visit www.doteasy.com to perform the CNAME setup.

7. Log in to the Doteasy Member Zone - <https://member.doteasy.com>
8. Click on DNS Panel (For Advanced User)
9. You will see two A Records, one for "yourdomain.com" and another for "www.yourdomain.com". For the A record for "www.yourdomain.com", click on "Edit"
10. Delete the text "DOTEASY IP ADDRESS" and replace with "web.mac.com"
11. Then click Submit

You're done! Please allow up to 24 hours for the DNS changes to take effect.
